Support Matters

- Adjust standard operating procedures to reflect current environment
- Develop training to further support employees



External Issues

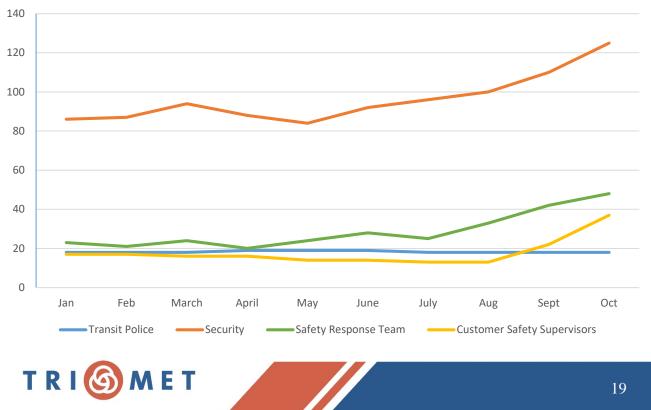

Transit Police Division

Team information:

- Taskforce model
- Managed by Multnomah County Sheriff's Office

Duties:

- Patrol the system
- Respond to serious incidents, emergencies
- Focuses on criminal behavior
- Assist riders and employees

Staffing: 18/65



Customer Safety Supervisors & Officers

Team Information:

- System-wide footprint
- Supervisors are TriMet employees
- Officers are contracted employees

Duties:

- Enforce the TriMet Code
- Provide education and direct riders to reduced fare programs
- Customer service
- Service disruption support

Staffing: CSS: 37 CSO: 29





Transit Security Officers

Staff Information:

- Contracted employees
- Located throughout the system

Duties:

- Provide unarmed system presence
- Encourage safe behavior around the system
- Assist riders and employees
- Help with service disruptions

Staffing: 96





Safety Response Team

- Within Safety and Security Division
- Pilot program began September 2021
- 48 people on bus and rail from diverse backgrounds
- Engage with all riders
- Provide basic staples and resource referral
