- Updated Agency Safety Plan goes to TriMet Board for review
- Adoption in December 2023

## Safety Management Systems (SMS)

- Set of protocols to manage safety risks and identify hazards throughout service district required now by the FTA
- SMS Leadership Team launched in fall of 2022
- ODOT State Safety Oversight (SSO) members serve on the team.

## **TriMet Drug and Alcohol Program**

- Oct. 2022: Passed FTA audit
- Mar. 2023: Revised Drug and Alcohol policy approved by TriMet Board
- 2023 random testing:
  - Random testing pool: 2295 safety sensitive employees
  - Random collections: 1038
  - Random positive test results: 9






### Transit Police Division Calls for Service 2022 & 2023






