# Statewide Transportation Improvement Program

- **STIF is a provision in HB 2017**
  - Payroll tax – 1/10<sup>th</sup> of 1%
  - \$69.6 mil projected in 2026
  - \$72.9 mil projected in 2027
- **Plan includes:**
  - Fare mitigation & student fares
  - Service expansion
  - Zero emission bus investments
  - Transit priority
  - Bus stop amenities & ADA improvements
  - Transportation for older adults and people with disabilities
  - First/last mile shuttles and regional transportation

# Statewide Transportation Improvement Program

- Plan submitted to ODOT every 2 years
- Advisory Committee input
  - TriMet Board of Director appoints the committee every two years
  - Must include representatives for:
    - Low-income individuals
    - Individuals aged 65 and older
    - People with disabilities
    - Public transportation service providers – both inside and outside the TriMet district

# Statewide Transportation Improvement Program

- **Updated Advisory Committee Bylaws**
  - One representative from each Board Member district
  - Term limits (maximum of 4 two-year terms)
  - Members on the committee by virtue of an elected position or organizational affiliation
  - Conflict of interest language
