



Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP)

- Current COOP published in 2018
- TriMet's Director of Emergency Management is working with TriMet leadership to update the COOP, focusing on:
 - Mission Essential Functions
 - Essential Systems Records and Resources
 - Orders of Succession
- Target Completion in 2026

Security Operations Center (SOC) Update

- **30% faster response times** by TriMet personnel
- **40% improvement in de-escalation** via early intervention and strategic deployment




Top 3 SOC Accomplishments in 2025

- **Major Event & Disruption Planning and Coordination Mission:**
Coordinated, planned, and led direct support operations for TriMet in over 17 major events, including large concerts, parades, holiday events, protests/rallies, and other civil unrest activities.
- **Predictive Analysis Report:**
Using advanced incident-management software, created analysis for data-informed strategic response
- **Increased Use of Ridership Tools:**
An average of 80-85 daily contacts into the SOC via our 24/7 security hotline and up to 56 weekly calls via our blue-light security phones














Fare Enforcement Activity

January 2025 – January 2026




Fare and Code Enforcement

January 2024 – January 2026




Reports of Smoke/Fumes

Bus: January 2023 – January 2026




Reports of Smoke/Fumes
