
Current Status:

- Ridership down by approximately 70%
- Service reduced by 21% starting April 5th
 - Weekday bus service preserved to hospitals, job centers, equity lines
 - Non-equity bus lines operate on Sat. schedules or modified weekday schedules on weekdays
 - All weekend bus service operates on Sun. schedules
 - MAX service reduced to 15 min. service
 - Only one bus line eliminated Line 272-PDX Night Bus; all other lines in the network preserved
 - 24-hour bus service on Lines 20-Burnside/Stark & 57-TV Highway eliminated
 - TriMet LIFT continues to meet requested demand




Fare Revenue:

- 77.5% decrease in HOP stored value loads








Payroll Tax Revenue: Expecting significant decrease


Projected Additional Expenses:

- Expecting an increase in enrollment for Low Income Fare program
- Legislature directed ODOT to merge the Special Transportation Funds program with STIF

Mitigation for decreased revenues and increased expenses:

- Prioritize the operating programs (i.e., the pie chart)
- Defer capital expenses (i.e., the "Triangle Funds")
- Position of the HB 2017 Transit Advisory Committee in 2018-19





HB 2017 & Special Transportation Funds (STF)

2019 Legislative session:

- Legislature directed ODOT to merge HB 2017 Funds and STF
- Maintains FY19-21 minimum base allocation (approx. \$5 mil) adjusted by rate of growth/decline
- Asked ODOT to develop a recommendation for how to merge the programs for the 2020 Legislative short session

2020 Legislative short session ended early

 Will have to include STF funds in FY21 STIF Plan without knowing how the programs will be merged

2021 Legislative session:

ODOT recommendation to be voted on prior to July 1, 2021






Equity Areas Update – 15% of blocks






Equity Areas Update – 20% of blocks






Equity Areas Update – 25% of blocks






Equity Areas Update – Change in Blocks






Equity Areas Update – Change in Blocks






Equity Areas Update – Change in Blocks
