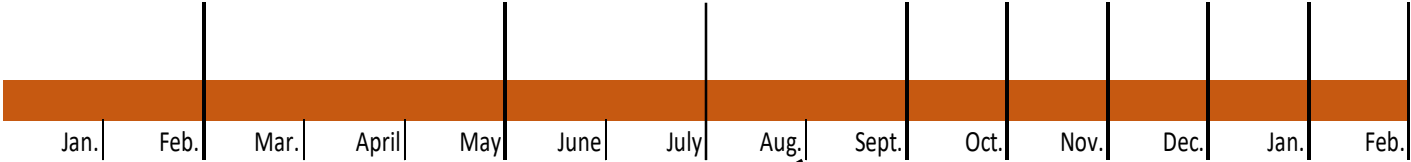

# Outreach – Low Income Fare

Total Comments: 157

1-5 Rating (5 is the highest): 67% rated a 4 or 5

92% supported growing the program

Common Themes:

- *This program is a lifeline*
- *Ideally free for all*
- *This is an important program*





# Outreach – Service Expansion

Total Comments: 144

1-5 Rating (5 is the highest): 77% rated a 4 or 5

Common Themes:

- *Want new service between Tualatin & Oregon City via Borland Rd., West Linn, & Wilsonville*
- *More frequency*
- *More service to low-income communities*



# Outreach – Battery Electric Buses

Total Comments: 149

1-5 Rating (5 is the highest): 67% rated a 4 or 5

Common Themes:

- *Deploy everywhere, low-income areas, & Lines 9, 12, 14, 15, 19*
- *This is important for decreasing air and noise pollution*
- *Prefer a trolley bus system like Seattle and San Francisco*



# Outreach – Transit Passes for Low-Income Students

Total Comments: 144

1-5 Rating (5 is the highest): 69% rated a 4 or 5

Common Themes:

- *Very important program, especially for low-income families*
- *There should be a youth pass for all families, regardless of income*
- *Students overcrowd the buses*



# Outreach – Regional Coordination

Total Comments: 123

1-5 Rating (5 is the highest): 63% rated a 4 or 5

Common Themes:

- *Crucial for last mile connections*
- *Expand to Borland Rd. – Rolling Hills Community Church*



# Outreach – Senior & Disabled Transportation Improvements

Total Comments: 150

1-5 Rating (5 is the highest): 86% rated a 4 or 5

Common Themes:

- *This is a lifeline*
- *LIFT monthly pass should be the same as an honored citizen monthly pass*
- *Make all bus stops ADA accessible*



# Outreach – Transit Priority

Total Comments: 119

1-5 Rating (5 is the highest): 68% rated a 4 or 5

Common Themes:

- *Transit priority should be on*
  - *all congested corridors*
  - *all Frequent Service Lines*
  - *all bridges*
- *Great program*



# Outreach – Bus Stop Amenities

Total Comments: 126

1-5 Rating (5 is the highest): 63% rated a 4 or 5

Common Themes:

- *Want more shelters, benches, & lighting system-wide*
- *Want cleaner bus stops*
- *Want more sidewalks and ADA accessibility*



# Outreach – Safety

Total Comments: 126

1-5 Rating (5 is the highest): 69% rated a 4 or 5

Common Themes:

- *Want more lighting at bus stops*
- *More fare enforcement*
- *More transit personnel onboard (not necessarily police)*





# Outreach – Service Preservation

Total Comments: 126

1-5 Rating (5 is the highest): 86% rated a 4 or 5

Common Themes:

- *Try to maintain service levels*
- *Help people get to work*
